Phone Investigation Recording

Investigator: Hello, hello.

Doctor: How could that be?

Investigator: Why not?

Doctor: Here, our Huashan Hospital just launched (liver transplantation) a few years ago.

Investigator: Oh... a few years ago? So your hospital ...

Doctor: Right, just launched a few years ago.

Investigator: Oh! Just a few years ago. Because I heard from a Japanese friend, that some of his Japanese friends have come to your hospital and done (transplantation). Was there such a case?

Doctor: I don't know about that.

Investigator: Oh, you don't know? If a Japanese friend can or cannot come for transplantation, you don't know? You, just said that you have done nearly 200 cases this year so far, are those (liver donors) healthy? Are they from young or elderly donors?

Doctor: I do not know about that! How could I know about this? The liver donor sources are confidential! It's the principle!

Investigator: Oh, you mean the donor ...

Doctor: I don't participate in medical treatment. How could I know the information regarding the donor livers?

Investigator: Oh...

Doctor: I don't participate in medical treatment. How could I know such details?

Investigator: Oh! You, said that there were almost 200 cases this year, were those all done by Director Wang? Was he always the chief surgeon?

Doctor: That's right! This...you... how about this, you go straight to his clinic to register and consult him, alright?

Investigator: Oh.

Doctor: I have no way to answer you so many questions!
