Phone Investigation Recording

Investigator: Hello, is that Gao Min? Gao Min: Hello, this is Gao Min, hello.

Investigator: I have a relative in Maoming City. He wants to do a kidney transplant surgery. I want to ask you, coordinator, in our area like Guangdong City or Shenzhen City, are there any organ donations?

Gao Min: So like this, for the organ donations, it is not like people are waiting for this. Now they are in short supply. So a lot of people are lining up in the hospitals. In the hospitals, they need to be checked by a doctor, who then has to confirm whether he has to do this kidney transplant or liver transplant. However, the diagnosis...

Investigator: I know. He said that when he went to Guangzhou, he said that he must wait.

Gao Min: Well, so...

Investigator: Hey, listen to me.

Gao Min: Yes.

Investigator: Guangzhou Hospital said that we have to wait, then I want to consider Shenzhen. You are relatively close to Hong Kong, so (people's minds) should be more open, so are there a lot of organ donations? Because we have always been waiting, and we don't know how longer we will wait. I think, hospitals in Shenzhen may be faster. Gao Min: Let me tell you, wait patiently. Now if there are organs in Shenzhen, then they would go to Guangzhou... now there's no qualified hospital for organ transplantation here.

Gao Min: Think about it, even if there is a donor, then the most one can donate would be two kidneys. But you know how many people in China (are waiting for kidney

transplants)? China has more than one million renal failure patients waiting for this kidney transplant every year. Then let's say we ignore the people, who don't have money, and people who don't want to do renal transplants or dialysis, then there would still be a lot, there would still be 300,000 patients (wanting to do a kidney transplant) a year. But what do we get in a year? Last year, during the whole year, the organ donations in the entire nation was less than 3,000 cases, 3,000 or 2,000, should be 2,600 cases. For these 2,600 donations, if you calculate, there would be only 5,200 kidneys, but if... Some are (not usable), then less than 5,200 kidneys, which can only save 5,200 people. They can't save a lot. Think about the number of 300,000. How many people are these, right? Investigator: Hmm.

Gao Min: Well, this is not to say whether there is donation or not. It is now that even many people want to donate.... I have more than a dozen body donations today. There was a young donor at 4 am this morning, at 32 years old. A car slammed into him, and his heart, liver and lungs were all crushed. Even his family wanted to donate his organs, they couldn't, so they only donated his body. Then how do you view it? It is not the issue of donation. The problem is that now even if he wants to donate, can he donate it? Most people would not be accepted. Many people donate, there are many donations in Yitian. We got people, who are just five months old, 12 years old and 15 years old. They can't donate successfully. It is not that they don't want to. So, being active or not is not important here. Yes, there are lots of limitations. If you've studied medicine yourself, you can understand the situation, right?
