Doctor: Hello!

Investigator: Hi, doctor, I have a patient, who wants a liver transplant. He's currently in the late stage of liver cirrhosis. He wants to have a liver transplant in your hospital. So we want to know how long does he have to wait for the surgery?

Investigator: But has your hospital done a lot of cases of liver transplant? How many can you do in a year?

Doctor: Between 40 to 50 cases.

Investigator: Oh, between 40 to 50 cases. Have you done any this year? How many have you done this year?

Doctor: Yes, we have done over 20 cases this year so far.

Investigator: Nowadays, the organ donors are healthier than the sources in the past, how about it? Healthy? Are there any health issues?

Doctor: Usually the donors are brain dead. If they had some other health issues, we wouldn't have used them.

Investigator: Oh, brain dead? So you use brain dead patients as organ donors, or do you have other organ sources?

Doctor: We have connections in Jiangsu, Anhui, Shandong and Henan Provinces, as far as organ donors are concerned. As long as donors are qualified, it shouldn't be a problem. Investigator: Oh, they will contact you once they have brain dead people, right? Doctor: That's right.

Investigator: Oh, do you know that the National Health Planning Commission have a website?

Doctor: It has a registration website, for all those organ donors to register online.

Investigator: Oh, you are not in direct contact with them, just obtaining the organ donors' information from the website?

Doctor: We have specialized organ coordinators, who contact the Red Cross Societies, instead of doctors.

Investigator: Ok. That's all I need. Thank you so much!

Doctor: Alright!

Investigator: Can I contact you later? What's your surname?

Doctor: My last name is Tang. You can come to find me directly when you come to our clinic. My last name is Tang.
