Wang Xuehao: Hello!

Investigator: Hello! Is that Director Wang Xuehao of Liver Transplant Department, at that Affiliated Hospital of Nanjing Medical University?

Wang Xuehao: Yes.

Investigator: Oh, how do you do? The situation is like this. I am the deputy director of the Office for Maintaining Stability at the Sichuan Provincial Political and Legal Affairs Commission. I have a relative, who lives in Shanghai and needs a liver transplant. So, I am calling you today, please give us some help!

Wang Xuehao: Ah?

Investigator: Yes, ah? He needs a liver transplant.

Wang Xuehao: Ah.

Investigator: Right.

Wang Xuehao: What blood type?

Investigator: Type B.

Wang Xuehao: What illness?

Investigator: He is 45 years old.

Wang Xuehao: What illness?

Investigator: Ah!

Wang Xuehao: What illness, tell me what illness he has.

Investigator: Hepatitis B, late-stage liver cirrhosis.

Wang Xuehao: Where is this patient now?

Investigator: Ah?

Wang Xuehao: Where is this patient? Where is he?

Investigator: He is in Shanghai.

Wang Xuehao: Does he plan to come to our hospital?

Investigator: Yes, he wants to go to your hospital to have the liver transplant, to do a liver transplant operation.

Wang Xuehao: Just tell him to come look for me on Monday!

Investigator: Right, I am checking to see what time is convenient for you. Please give us some help.

Wang Xuehao: Tell him (to come) Monday morning.

Investigator: Okay.

Wang Xuehao: I will be at the academician's clinic session on Monday morning.

Investigator: Okay. I have another question. After he comes, how long does it take for you to arrange the operation?

Wang Xuehao: What is his blood type?

Investigator: Blood Type B.

Wang Xuehao: Wait time is short for Type B. Usually it won't take more than two weeks. Investigator: Won't take more than two weeks?

Wang Xuehao: Less than two weeks.

Investigator: I would like to ask a question about the organ donors, do you usually use those...

Wang Xuehao: Organs are from the center.

Investigator: Ah, they are the normal and healthy organs of Falun Gong practitioners, right?

Wang Xuehao: Organs are from the center.

Investigator: All right. Speaking of the organs, the quality of the organs, as you know the quality of the organs has a direct impact on the successfulness of the operation. So,

Director Wang, please help us make sure the quality of the organ is good.

Wang Xuehao: We need to do tissue-typing, and we will have to do an evaluation. Investigator: All right, all right. Okay, shall we have further discussions when he comes

to see you? All right.

Wang Xuehao: Oh, okay, good.

Investigator: I have more questions. Do you extract the organs inside your hospital and arrange the extraction and a simultaneous organ transplant, or do you get the organs from outside of your hospital?

Wang Xuehao: Most organs come from outside of our hospital.

Investigator: Oh.

Wang Xuehao: Most organs are from the organ transplant center.

Investigator: Oh, what center?

Wang Xuehao: Organ transplant center, it's not easy to tell you clearly over the phone.

Investigator: Um, Okay, did you just say it is from the center of brain deaths? Wang Xuehao: Ah, yes. Investigator: Extracted at the center of brain deaths and bring them in for the transplant? Wang Xuehao: Oh, oh, oh. Investigator: Okay, fine. Wang Xuehao: Uh. Investigator: Okay. Wang Xuehao: Okay. Investigator: All right, we will see you on Monday. Good. Wang Xuehao: Umm, good.
