Phone Investigation Recording

Nurse: Hi...

Investigator: Is that the kidney transplant department of the General Hospital of Shenyang Military Region?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Oh, do you still take patients? We have one patient who, wants to be transferred to you.

Nurse: Transfer? What kinds of illness?

Investigator: Kidney failure caused by diabetes. We suggested him to have a kidney transplant and he agreed. However, he suggested that we find a hospital with more skillful doctors and lower expenses, just like the General Hospital of Shenyang Military Region.

Nurse: Where are you from?

Investigator: Shandong Province.

Nurse: From a hospital?

Investigator: Yeah, I'm from a small hospital: Xuecheng Hospital.

Nurse: Alright. You have to let him come and have a look, then we'll the tissue typing and see whether he is suitable for (a transplant) or not.

Investigator: Ah... He will do it for sure. But how long is the wait time at your estimation?

Nurse:(Waiting for) kidney sources?

Investigator: Right.

Nurse: Hard to say.

Investigator: You may just give a rough estimate. Go ahead.

Nurse: It may take several months, or even a year or a couple of years.

Investigator: Such a long time?

Nurse: Um.

Investigator: It means you might be. Shouldn't we ...

Nurse: He has to come here in person and have a tissue typing, then get registered here.

Investigator: Yes. We are just asking on his behalf to inquire about the situation first, including which hospital. (Nurse: Ah) Is it true that your wait time is short and how about the skill level? And do you do many cases?

Nurse: Yes, we definitely do a lot of cases.

Investigator: How many cases a year can you do? How many have you done this year?

Nurse: Um, about 100 cases.

Investigator: Now it is 100, over 100, isn't it?

Nurse: For the specific figure, you will have to consult the doctors, because we have assigned doctors to answer this. We nurse...

Investigator: I know. If over 100 cases a year, the wait time should not be too long, right? Your kidney sources are relatively ample.

Nurse: But the queue is also long.

Investigator: The queue is also long?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: The ward beds are in short supply?

Nurse: Yes, but still OK. First come, first serve.

Investigator: Um, I know. The number of ward beds exceeds several dozens, or even over 50?

Nurse: No, no.

Investigator: Another thing is that, how about the organ quality?

Nurse: For such a technical question... you'd ask the doctors. OK?

Investigator: Which doctor? Could you give me some hint?
