Chen Xinguo: Hello?

Investigator: Hello. Is that Director Chen? Is that Director Chen Xinguo from the Liver

Transplant Center of the Armed Police General Hospital?

Chen Xinguo: Yes.

Investigator: How are you? I'm calling from Chengdu, Sichuan. I am the deputy director of the Office for Maintaining Stability at the Sichuan Provincial Political and Legal Affairs Commission. So, here is my situation. I have a patient, who is a relative of mine living in Fengtai District. He has end-stage cirrhosis and needs a liver transplant.

Chen Xinguo: Ah.

Investigator: Some friend recommended your hospital to you, telling me that you could do (transplants) faster and quite well. So, I am asking for your help.

Chen Xinguo: Ah, ah, yes. He is now in Beijing, right?

Investigator: Yes, in Beijing, in Fengtai.

Chen Xinguo: Oh, in Fengtai. Good. Fengtai, then should be in our (Armed Police) General Hospital.

Investigator: Right. I just want to ask, if he comes to your place, how fast will the surgery be arranged?

Chen Xinguo: You let him visit me this Sunday. It depends on the situation. What blood type?

Investigator: His blood type is B.

Chen Xinguo: Oh, then it should not take long.

Investigator: Yes, blood type B. (He is) about 45 years old this year, almost 46 years old.

Chen Xinguo: Ah, then he should not wait for long.

Investigator: Then approximately how long?

Chen Xinguo: Probably within this month, (the surgery) should take place by the end of October.

Investigator: So, you are saying by the end of October. So, he can do it in October, right?

Chen Xinguo: Right, right, right.

Investigator: So that's within one to two weeks, correct?

Chen Xinguo: Should be within one to two weeks. That should work if there's no special situation.

Investigator: He should be in relatively good condition.

Chen Xinguo: Special cases... such as being very short, ... inapposite matching, special cases...

Investigator: He is not in any of those special cases. His health condition should be relatively good.

Chen Xinguo: I am talking about his height and weight?

Investigator: His height is like, 170 centimeters (5'7"). His weight is over 130 jin (143 pounds).

Chen Xinguo: Ah, that's fine. That is relatively fine. For overweight ones or ...

Investigator: He should not be overweight. His condition is relatively good. So, this is to say, within one week after coming, he can do the transplant, right?

Chen Xinguo: Roughly speaking, yes.

Investigator: Roughly speaking?

Chen Xinguo: It should be able to take place by the end of this month.

Investigator: Since your voice was not very clear just a moment ago, let me confirm once again. So, we should visit your place on Monday morning, right? Monday morning.

Chen Xinguo: Yes, come to me in the morning on Monday.

Investigator: And then? Roughly within one week, the surgery can be arranged, right?

Chen Xinguo: One week? Uh, I think probably by the end of this month.

Investigator: Probably by the end of this month, so that's one or two weeks, right?

Chen Xinguo: Uh, uh.

Investigator: Also, regarding the donor, you say that you are confident that (he) is very healthy, in normal condition, right?

Chen Xinguo: Of course, healthy. We do a lot of cases every month, so that's hundred percent...

Investigator: Yes, I heard that you do a lot?

Chen Xinguo: Just rest assured! Ha.

Investigator: Okay. Also, I have another question to ask you. About the donor, you know, the donor is directly related to the success or failure of this surgery.

Chen Xinguo: Right.

Investigator: So, (the donor) has to be healthy. I heard that, some of them were not in good health condition. Because some of them were subjected to tortures, such as the tiger bench, or were forced to go on hunger strikes! So, the physical condition was not very good. You don't have those kinds (of donors) here, right?

Chen Xinguo: No, we don't.

Investigator: Okay, so you don't. So, you still keep them in a healthy condition, right?

Chen Xinguo: Well~ You, you, please rest assured!

Investigator: Okay. So, you can let them live in normal conditions, or some of them can even do exercises there, right?

Chen Xinguo: Right, regarding this, please rest assured. Because we have been doing this every day, right? We do many cases every day. It is routine. Ha.

Investigator: Right. I just want to say, please do quality control regarding the donors. The best type would be, for example, from prison...

Chen Xinguo: No, no, no! We have done so many. We care about the quality.

Investigator: Right. We can't use the ones that underwent tortures or hunger strikes. This [type of organs] is not the best. It is better to have them in the normal state. Those who do the practice would be even better.

Chen Xinguo: Don't worry, we have done a lot, I will check it for you, ah!

Investigator: Great! Especially the ones that practice Falun Gong, they would be the best.

Chen Xinguo: Okay! Okay!
