Summary

Dr. Han from Guangzhou First Affiliated Hospital, Sun Yat-sen University confirmed twice when talking about using Falun Gong practitioners' organs for transplantation.

On November 25, 2015 a WOIPFG investigator called Dr. Han from Guangzhou First Affiliated Hospital, Sun Yat-sen University over the phone. Dr. Han said, "We actually have done more than 1,500 cases!" When speaking of human organ banks of imprisoned Falun Gong practitioners and the organs used for transplants being from Falun Gong practitioners, Han confirmed twice by saying "yes, that's right".

Phone Investigation Recording

Investigator: Would you please tell me if you can do liver transplantation now?

Dr. Han: Where are you calling from?

Investigator: I'm from Beijing. There are not so many organ donors there, so I want to ask you about this. Since Huang Jiefu was the president of your hospital, you must have a lot of experiences on this.

Dr. Han: We indeed did a lot. It's for sure that we can do this.

Investigator: So you can still do this, right? You still have enough organ donors, right? Well, how long I have to wait approximately?

Dr. Han: All the patients need to wait, for two months on average.

Investigator: So Huang Jiefu is no longer working in your hospital, right?

Dr. Han: He had left here for a long time. He left in 2003 to work in the Ministry of Health.

Investigator: I know that he has done a lot of transplants. For liver transplantation alone, he had performed more than 500 cases.

Dr. Han: More than 500 cases? By now we have done more than 1,500 cases.

Investigator: Wonderful, that's why we know you are the best in both quantity and quality. Well, you may know Huang Jiefu's speeches during the two national conferences, he said that the organs came from so-called executed prisoners. In fact, he said that after Zhou Yongkang was arrested, the benefit chain was cut, and Bai Shuzhong, the Director of Health Department of the PLA General Logistics Department had told the world that when Jiang Zemin was in power, it was him that issued the order to harvest organs from living Falun Gong practitioners for transplantation. There are 36 concentration camps in China to imprison Falun Gong practitioners. So their organs are used for transplantation. When many patients heard this, they

all requested for such donor organs. Why? Because these donors are all healthy and they are practitioners.

Dr. Han: Yes, that's right. It is true that things were like that before. Now it doesn't work that way because of the international society. We have to stop right now and we can't do it that way. Starting from January 1 this year, we have announced that we are no longer allowed to use that kind of organs.

Investigator: So you are not allowed now. Well, that means in the past, you did, as long as the organs were from Falun Gong practitioners, all imprisoned Falun Gong practitioners' organs could be used for transplants. But now you are no longer allowed, right?

Dr. Han: It's not about Falun Gong. It has nothing to do with Falun Gong, do you understand what I mean? Don't get Falun Gong involved in this. It's different now. It's not allowed now, in the international society.

Investigator: It's right. I saw the news, too. I often read online news and pay attention to this kind of news. It is well known to the world that the Chinese Communist Party is harvesting organs from living Falun Gong practitioners for transplantation.

Dr. Han: Let's not discuss this, all right? No discussion on this. If you want transplantation, you can come over and register here to take examinations, ok?

Investigator: So that means your hospital still can do this, and you still have donor organs. Thus, I can come over. Well, may I contact you?

Dr. Han: Yes, you can. Just call this number and you can find me.

Investigator: May I please have your name?

Dr. Han: Dr. Han.

Investigator: well, I just need to call this number to find you, is that right?

Dr. Han: Yes, right.

Investigator: All right, that's all. Thank you.

Dr. Han: If you come over, please call me.

Investigator: Okay, bye.
