Phone Investigation Recording

Investigator: Hello, is that Doctor Lang Ren at Chao-Yang Hospital? I am a doctor, I am at the PLA No. 316 Hospital in Beijing. I would like to ask if you can do liver transplantation at your hospital.

Lang Ren: Who is that? (Investigator: Ah?) Where are you calling from?

Investigator: Uh, I am...We are in Haidian, do you know? Haidian, Yuquanshan, we are at the PLA No. 316 Hospital in Beijing under the People's Liberation Army General Staff Department. I am a doctor, and we have a patient, who wants to do a liver transplant. Can you still do it over there?

Lang Ren: He can do it in Beijing, and we can do it in our hospital, too.

Investigator: Oh, since, since there are some hospitals, which do a lot (of organ transplants), and there are quite a few patients waiting there, I asked a few hospitals, which all stopped doing it. Even the China-Japan Friendship Hospital doesn't do it anymore. So, I try to ask if you still do it over there.

Lang Ren: Yes, yes, they don't do it at the China-Japan Friendship Hospital, but we do, kidney transplants.

Investigator: Oh, how long does it take for the patient to wait (for the organ) after arrival? Lang Ren: It depends on the situation of the patient.

Investigator: His blood type is B, his blood type is B, his blood type is B.

Lang Ren: Oh, so this is the case. It depends on his current situation. If it is critical, we would have a green channel; if it is the general situation, he needs to wait two weeks the longest in our hospital, because our donor sources are very abundant.

Investigator: Oh, that's great, that's great. I asked a lot of hospitals, which stopped doing it, because there were too many patients waiting. Then have you started doing transplants this year, in 2016?

Lang Ren: We, we have been doing it for over ten years, and for over 1,000 patients.

Investigator: Hey, you said that you have already started doing it this year in 2016, how many? Lang Ren: We have done over a dozen.

Investigator: Ah.

Lang Ren: There are more than a dozen cases.

Investigator: Oh, more than a dozen cases. That's great, that's great.

Lang Ren: Ah.

Investigator: I just asked another hospital, and they said that they didn't do any this year. Ok, then, then, let me ask the price again. Tell me about the price. So I can tell him.

Lang Ren: This price depends on the general situation. The differences could be very large.

Actually, if the situation is very good, the cost will not be very high. If the patient is in a very

critical condition, or if there is a complication, the cost will be high. It depends.

Investigator: Well, it's not certain. You can't decide the price for certain.

Lang Ren: Right, it depends on the illness. I have to take a look at his (medical) records. I can't answer you on this kind of things.

Investigator: Uh, generally speaking, under normal circumstances, around, around how much? Lang Ren: This is not very certain, usually it is about 700,000 to 800,000 yuan.

Investigator: Ah, okay then, if you tell me how much, I will tell him, then I will talk with him, discuss it. If he agrees, then we will go over as soon as possible.

Lang Ren: You, he's not a foreigner, right? How can foreigners do it?

Investigator: Not a foreigner, he is a soldier, haha.

Lang Ren: Ah, right, right. Foreigners are not allowed.

Investigator: Ah, okay, then I will talk with him about it.

Lang Ren: Good.

Investigator: If he agrees, we will go there as soon as possible.

Lang Ren: After your discussion, if the information, if the signs are okay, you can just contact me, okay?

Investigator: Ok, good, good.

Lang Ren: Recently we have a lot of surgeries. If we don't answer the phone, you can send me a text message. Can I call you back?

Investigator: Today, you have done more than a dozen cases in January and February this year? Lang Ren: Yes, yes, uh.

Investigator: That's not bad.

Lang Ren: Surgery, surgery----they should be all surgeries.

Investigator: Ah, the 1,000 cases that you just mentioned were performed in one year?

Lang Ren: In 10 years.

Investigator: Oh, that's good, that's good. That's about it, thank you. I will discuss it with him, then I will contact you. Good, thank you, goodbye, goodbye, um.
