Summary

1. “(We have done) close to over 50 cases (of liver transplants this year).”
2. “Director Peng and Director Ye are the main surgeons. Then Professor Ye (Ye Qifa) would do it sometimes.”
3. Director Ye Shaojun is the nephew of Ye Qifa. He has done a lot of surgeries.
4. “We often perform emergency transplant surgeries.”
5. The hospital has a specialized ward for kidney and liver transplantation, with about 70 beds.
6. The total cost of surgery and finding the liver source is 600,000 yuan.
7. “Some (organ) wait times were quite short, because some of them were urgent.”

Phone Investigation Recording

Investigator: Hi doctor, hello!

Doctor: Hello.

Investigator: Hello, hello! Well, here is the case. I'd like to ask, regarding patient's tissue typing in your hospital, what time...

Doctor: What? How to do tissue typing? Hello?

Investigator: Hello, eh, my voice is not very clear. Isn't it true that for those, who need liver transplantation, they should register first, come to your hospital to register?

Doctor: Yes, that's right.

Investigator: Oh, so register with you there, right?

Doctor: Correct.

Investigator: Oh, what is your current fee? A routine one, not a special case, roughly?

Doctor: Well, in general, you mean liver transplantation?

Investigator: Ah, yes.

Doctor: The liver transplantation costs around 600,000 (yuan).

Investigator: Oh~ you, for example another hospital said that the liver source fee and the surgery fee are separate. How much is your liver source fee?

Doctor: Uh, our fee here is a total of 600,000 (yuan), including those.

Investigator: Oh, I see. Hey, how many liver transplants have you done so far this year?

Doctor: Uh ~ close to over 50 cases. I am not very clear about the details.

Investigator: Then may I ask who are doing it? I mean liver transplantation. Is that Director Peng?

Doctor: Well, Director Peng and Director Ye are the main surgeons. Then Professor Ye would do it sometimes, but he doesn't do it often. Sometimes he does, uh.

Investigator: Director Peng is the main surgeon, right?

Investigator: Oh, did you refer to Ye Qifa?

Doctor: Well, he is a nephew of Ye Qifa. He is also a doctor here, and a deputy director of a department. He also performs surgeries, liver transplantation.

Investigator: Oh, I haven't heard of him. What is his full name?

Doctor: Ye Shaojun.

Investigator: Ye, oh, Ye Shaojun? I don't think I've heard of him. Was he transferred from another hospital?

Doctor: Well, yes, he was also brought here by Professor Ye.

Investigator: Then his surgical skills is okay, right?

Doctor: Well, it shouldn't be an issue. He did a little more than Director Peng.

Investigator: Oh~ Director Peng is quite old, so he doesn't do much, right?

Doctor: Well, he is still doing it, and he is doing a lot.

Investigator: Oh, in those 50 cases of liver transplantation you did this year, for those patients, who waited relatively longer for the liver, how long did they wait?

Doctor: Uh~ Each case was different. Some wait times were quite short, because some of them were urgent, like acute and severe liver failure. He must have transplantation right away. In general, if having a liver disease, the patient may not survive after a few months' wait, so it's usually done pretty soon, if they stay in our hospital.

Investigator: Eh, if it's really that kind of emergency that needs liver transplantation, do you have the suitable conditions? Because some hospitals don't have the condition to do...

Doctor: Yes, we do!

Investigator: You do?

Doctor: Yes, right, we often perform emergency transplant surgeries.

Investigator: You perform emergency transplantation often?

Doctor: Uh, yes.

Investigator: Oh, your kidney transplantation, your liver and kidney transplantation, has a specialized ward, right? Not mixed with other urinary surgery (patients), right? specialized...

Doctor: We don't mix them together, separate, they are separate. We all do transplantation here.

Investigator: Oh, then, this is better, in terms of management... How many beds do you have?

Doctor: About 70 or so!

Investigator: Around 70, then your beds...

Doctor: Over 70, in general, we do a little bit over 70.

Investigator: Most of the beds are occupied, right? It should be, there won't be many...

Doctor: Well, uh! Yep!

Doctor: Yes, it's possible, it's possible. They will make the arrangement. When the new patients come, they will discharge some patients, who are not in a critical condition, let them leave hospital first.

Investigator: Oh, usually how long will the patient stay at the hospital after surgery before being discharged?

Doctor: It usually takes a month here, roughly. If the liver is very bad, a month and a half after surgery, the patient may go home.

Investigator: Oh, kidney transplants may not need one month?

Doctor: Yes, in the case of kidneys, it's even faster.

Investigator: Oh, because this concerns the expenses, so we'd like to get some information.

Doctor: Ok, sure.

Investigator: Ok, when we get there, we will call this number of yours to contact you.

Doctor: Yes, yes, that's right.

Investigator: Director Ye Shaojun you just mentioned, can we have his number?

Doctor: Sorry no. Director Ye's number is private. Sometimes we gave it out, his phone was jammed with calls.

Investigator: Oh, hehe, yes, okay, okay, goodbye, haha.

Doctor: Uh, uh, ok, all right.
