Doctor: Relatively speaking, it is more quickly here, because in Shanghai, Renji

(Hospital) does a little more than we do. We have done a lot here, also.

Investigator: For example, how many cases have you done this year? Have you done a lot?

Doctor: We did a lot, did them in Shanghai. You are an adult, right?

Investigator: Oh \sim

Doctor: We have done quite a lot here. We do nearly 200 cases every year.

Investigator: 200 cases, how about this year, have you done a lot this year?

Doctor: This year, we will break through 200 cases.

Investigator: This year, you can break through 200 cases. Have you done 200 cases by

now?

Doctor: We haven't counted them yet. Anyway, we did four operations last week.

Investigator: Oh, that's still a lot of cases. How about the fees? The costs?

Doctor: Generally speaking, the cost of the first hospitalization is at least 600,000 (yuan).

Investigator: Doctor, I would like to ask you, can you make sure that the donor is

relatively healthy, such as young people? You said that there are many people in our

country, who sell kidneys (Doctor: well) and livers. Can, can we find this kind of persons?

Those who sell kidneys and livers? Is that possible?

Doctor: It is impossible for someone to sell his liver. Someone may sell a kidney. But no

one will sell his liver.

Investigator: No one sells his liver. I thought the liver and kidney...

Doctor: The human body has only one liver, so it is impossible for one to sell his own

liver.

Investigator: Oh.

Doctor: Regarding the specifics, you need to come over, and then have a face-to-face talk

with the professor of our transplantation group, okay?

Investigator: It means that a liver cannot be sold in half?

Doctor: No.

Investigator: It is infeasible? Okay, you say that kidneys can be sold. How much is a

kidney if someone wants to have a kidney transplantation?

Doctor: We don't need kidneys. We only do liver transplantation. Kidney transplantation

is another ~

Investigator: Oh, okay, thank you, may I ask your surname? If I go to your hospital, can I

ask to have a meeting with you? I'll let the patient meet you.

Doctor: No, because I am on duty. I am the doctor-on-duty. You must find our director,

who is the professor of liver transplantation.

Investigator: Oh, oh, okay, good. Doctor, what is the surname of the professor, who

mainly does liver transplantation?

Doctor: His surname is Wang. He's called Wang Zhengxin, Professor Wang.

Investigator: Oh, okay, okay, Wang Zhengxin, okay, so, so...
