2. “There’s been quite a lot this year. Sometimes we do two in a day.”
3. More transplants have been done this year than last year!
4. “I just asked. Not yet 50 (transplants this year).”

Phone Investigation Recording

Investigator: Hi, how are you? Is that Xijing Hospital, department of liver transplant?

Doctor: Yes!

Investigator: Okay. I want to ask you about liver transplants in your hospital. Do you still do them?

Doctor: Yes, we do.

Investigator: Okay. You are still doing them! That means you do... (D: Yes) them pretty well?

Doctor: Ha, that’s for sure. Not bad!

Investigator: Not bad! Let’s say this year, how many have you done, liver transplants? Because I have a family member...

Doctor: We do them this year.

Investigator: Pardon? What did you say? You..

Doctor: What are you asking? How many cases have been done this year?

Investigator: Yes! That is my question.

Doctor: It is not convenient for me to disclose this information. Anyway, quite some this year. About one (transplant) every seven or eight days! If there’re a lot, sometimes we do two in a day.

Investigator: Well. You said you have done over 100 liver transplants so far?

Doctor: In total so far?

Investigator: Yes.

Doctor: This year or?

Investigator: This year. How many have been done this year? A lot?

Doctor: So far probably less than 100. Quite a lot have been done this year.

Investigator: Just this year? Then not many last year?

Doctor: Because after the year 2015, the policy has been changed. Then, we had fewer liver sources. So it must be less compared to before.

Investigator: Less.. that is... of course.. that it must be the case. There were a lot of inmates and people practicing (Falun) Gong and we could just use those peoples' (organs) in large batches. At that time, every hospital did a lot of organ transplants. Your hospital did a lot, as well.

Doctor: Yes. Yes.

Investigator: Is it the case that there may be more in this year than last year?

Doctor: Yes. This is true.

Investigator: You said you had done...till now, about September now, you had done over 100 (transplants)?

Doctor: Well.. That should not be the case. Probably less than 100 cases.

Investigator: Last year, several dozen (transplants) were done, probably less than 100 cases, maybe something like 60 or 70. I have asked the others.

Doctor: Right!

Investigator: Well, you said a few dozens had been done this year?

Doctor: Well.. that is about the case.

Investigator: Really? Then it means it will surpass last year, at least doubling the volume of last year, over 100!

Doctor: That...we'll need to see how things will go.

Investigator: Going forward...OK.

Doctor: This thing...I cannot guarantee.

Investigator: So it's hard to say. Why do you think you have so many this year? Is it because you have more donors, more than last year?

Doctor: Well, well, well, I do not know why there are more, either ... Because I am new here, so I am not too sure.

Investigator: Really? That should be the case!

Doctor: Right!

Investigator: No problems with the health (of the donors)?

Doctor: Right!

Investigator: That is...Usually those people are not like me, as a doctor... But I am especially concerned with the donors. What if it is from somebody, who is old or with congenital diseases? About that please...

Doctor: That will not happen.

Investigator: Okay. Is it usually young people? Or more older people?

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: I, I asked more young people or more old people? The donors of these organs!

Doctor: There are more young donors!

Investigator: More young people!

Doctor: Right!

Investigator: Is it still Director Yuan who is in charge?

Doctor: No Director Yuan. You need to wait for Zhang Hongtao. Ask Zhang Hongtao when his is back!

Investigator: OK. The person has been changed. Early on, maybe last year, or the year before, it was Director Dou and Director Yuan, who were in charge. Now it is Zhang.

Doctor: As to Director Yuan... would you like to ask Director Yang, Director Yang Zhaoxu, Director Yang.

Investigator: Yang Zhaoxu. OK. OK. OK I see. Then it's fine then.

Doctor: OK.

Investigator: Then I am done.

Doctor: OK.

Investigator: Thank you. But if I have the opportunity...

Doctor: Well, Well. That's fine.

Investigator: Well. You have not, just now, you have not told me approximately how many have been done this year, so I can have the right expectations. I need to see how long I need to wait for the transplant.

Doctor: OK. Just wait a minute. I will go ask someone.

Investigator: Yes. Thank you!

Doctor: OK (asking around). Hello, hi!

Investigator: Yes. Hi. Please tell me. Hello.

Doctor: I just asked. Not yet 50 (transplants).

Investigator: OK. Good. Then I know. That's it. Thank you!

Doctor: OK!

Investigator: Thank you!

Doctor: OK. No problem.
