Doctor: Yes, they are.

Investigator: How come your donors come faster than the big hospitals in Beijing? You have plenty of donors!

Doctor: Yes, we have plenty of donors.

Investigator: What kind of donors are yours in general?

Doctor: No comment, no comment. Please do not ask about this.

Investigator: Oh. I shouldn't ask about this?

Doctor: Right. Do not ask about it.

Doctor: 16th Floor, the Liver Transplantation Department.
